Being included in such a prestigious squad at such an early stage in his career highlights how highly regarded he is by the selectors. It's a big deal for a young bowler, especially in a country that has produced some world-class talent in recent years, like Rashid Khan and Mujeeb ur Rahman.

Khalil's all-action style and seam bowling skills, combined with his hunger for improvement, make him a promising candidate for a stint in the UK. Playing in the UK would be a great opportunity to broaden his skill set, particularly in conditions that could challenge and refine his game, and would offer invaluable experience as he plots his way to the top of the game.

Khalil is the type of player who could thrive in a club environment, where he has the chance to play regular cricket and, most importantly, build on his potential as a match-winner. If he can keep building on his already impressive foundation, it's not hard to see him becoming a key player for Afghanistan in the future. We highly recommended Khalil

for a UK stint in 2025, he may well be a little gem in UK conditions.
