Mandy Mangru is an outstanding all-round cricketer who recently received her maiden West Indies call-up for the Women's T20 World Cup in the UAE (October 2024).

Her selection was a by-product of her success in the T20 Blaze Competition (Regional Tournament) earlier this year when finishing as one of the top 5 run-scorers.

Mangru's inclusion isn't her first Windies call-up, as she'd previously made his ODI debut against South Africa during the Windies' tour in 2022.

A genuine all-rounder, Mangru bats top-middle order, keeps wicket, and bowls off-spin. Behind the stumps, she is known for her sharp reflexes, quick hands, and the ability to pull off crucial stumpings, and catches in pressure moments. As a batter, she is versatile and reliable, able to anchor an innings or provide the aggressive acceleration her team needs.

In addition to her keeping duties, she is also a skilled off-spin bowler, capable of breaking partnerships with her clever variations and accuracy. In the field, she is agile, with excellent awareness and a strong throwing arm, making her a threat in any position. Her all-round abilities and leadership on the field make her an invaluable asset to any team.

Mangru is quite the prospect who is looking to forge a regular spot in the Windies Women's side in years to come. In

2025, she is eager to spend a season plying her trade in the UK to continue her development, and is a player that we, and her head coach (Shane Deitz) highly recommends.
