Marco's recent seasons have been spent turning out for Knights Cubs Under 19's in 2020, before graduation into senior cricket for the Free State Colts from 2020 to the present day. Preferably an opening batsman, Marco's looks to occupy the crease and build his innings. Having the ability to shift gear when needed, the 'Saffa' averages over 50 during the current season.

Set to embark on his first stint in the Northern Hemisphere, the South African will join up with Dutch Club - Groen & Wit for their upcoming Hoofdklasse campaign in May.
