He returned in 2022 to dominate for Bristol Cricket Club in the West of England Premier League, amassing over 750 runs at an average of 50, including a career-best 192. He also featured for Gloucestershire 2nd XI, gaining valuable County exposure.

Beyond playing, Renwick is a highly qualified coach, holding an NZC Advanced Development Level 2 certification (ECB Level 3 equivalent). Passionate about player development, he is eager to contribute both on and off the field in the UK.
